Just a reminder that we need to be able to contact parents and carers at all times and you will need to be able to collect your son or daughter quickly should they become unwell at school.

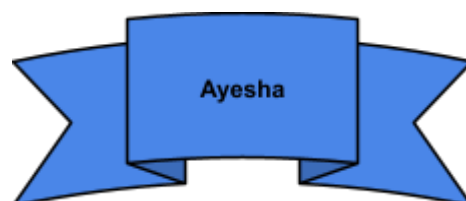
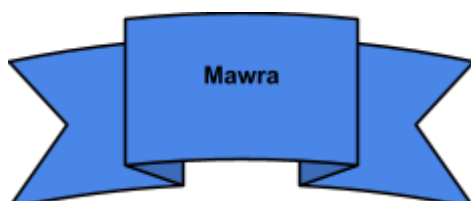

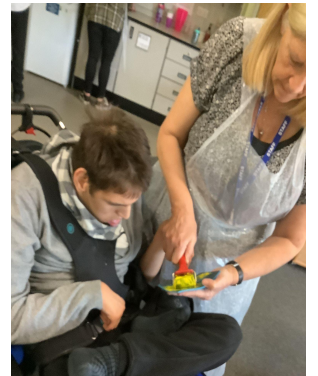
