Dear parents and carers

We have come to the end of our first week back and it has been an extremely busy and complex one. Thank you for your patience and understanding. We are doing our very best to navigate the situation to ensure we can offer the very best in the circumstances.

All of you who requested home learning packs will have them by now and everyone should have received at least one phone call from their class teacher to discuss learning and what is on offer until 15th January. From that point onwards, for those students still at home, we are moving to an online learning platform called 'Class Dojo.' This will replace the blog and allows each teacher to set up a virtual classroom with their own students. It enables us to have live lessons, recorded lessons and post up tasks and resources and allows you to post photos and videos of your son or daughter's learning to then receive feedback from the teacher. Further details will be out next week after our teachers have been trained on Tuesday evening. We will also offer a weekly Zoom timetable which will include the choir, music lessons and some other subjects for you to choose from. We hope this will be a good system enabling good quality learning, that will also enable your son or daughter and you, to receive feedback. We hope it will also help our students to feel they are still very much in touch with us.

We are also taking orders for any visual aids you may need. Please let your class teacher know if you need any symbols, visual timetables, social stories, now and next boards or anything else and we will make them up and deliver them to you.

Just a reminder that therapists are available for on-line consultations and can be contacted directly. If you need any contact details, please do let us know. Similarly, Marta, our nurse is available and we will do whatever we can to support during this period of time.
