We have had a great day in our pyjamas listening to bedtime stories.

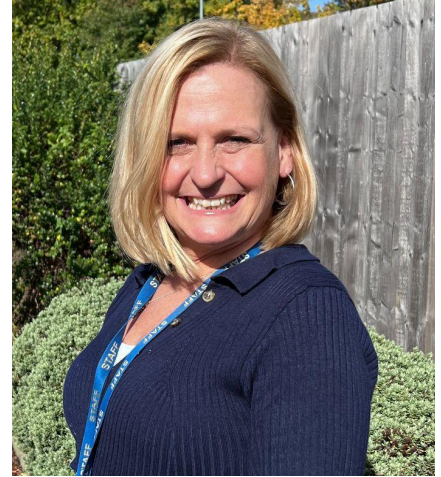

We look forward to more trips and time out in the community as the term continues. Today we will be celebrating World Book Day and listening to bedtime stories this afternoon.

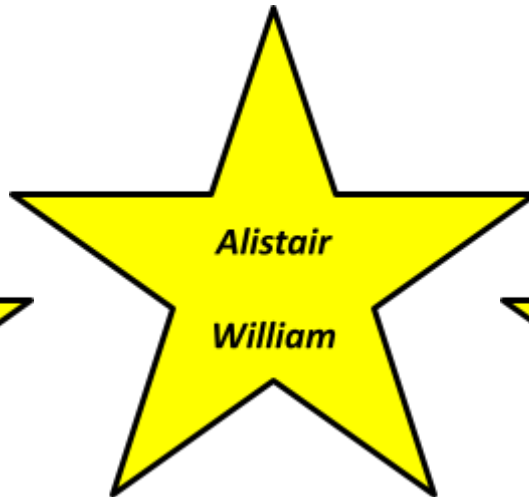


GOLD CLASS
